## **Ghyll Road, Heathfield**

Dear Resident

We will be carrying out carriageway resurfacing works on Ghyll Road, Heathfield.

Work will start on Monday 4th February 2019 and continue for 5 nights.

Ghyll Road will be closed to through traffic from B2203 Hailsham Road to Swaines Way between 7.30pm & 6am each night.

The road will be closed to through traffic. This is for your safety and the safety of our workers. If you do need vehicle access, then please discuss this with the team on site. We will try to give access where we can but there may be long delays whilst we make the area safe. We will always allow access for emergency vehicles. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

We will also be working at the junction with Geers Wood on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February for 1 night between 8pm & 6am. We will endeavour to complete the work and re-open the road as early as possible. If residents of Geers Wood require vehicle access during our working hours, we would advise them to park outside the closure.

We will also have roadworks further along Ghyll Road between Swaines Way & A267 during the week whilst we bolt down speed cushions. The road will be closed to through traffic but we will be allowing access. Delays likely.

If it rains, we might be delayed in our works. We will keep you updated with any changes via advanced warning signs.

There will be 'no parking' signs and cones on site to advise where parking is restricted.
